



Musical Instrument Making Workshops

Years 5 and 6

Pupils from one class make an 11 note diatonic Batonka or a Marimba over 3 days. Using a separate classroom the workshop leader works with a group of 3 pupils on a rotational basis throughout the day. This is a real opportunity for pupils to develop DT skills as well as the understanding of science and music.

Years 2,3 and 4

Younger pupils can make a Metallophone, a Marimba or a set of Mini-Batonkas. As with years 5 - 6 the workshop leader works with groups of three or four pupils at a time in a separate classroom for the day. The school benefits from having a new classroom instruments.
